ANIMAL RESCUE ENTITY LICENSE APPLICATION



PURSUANT TO DOUGLAS COUNTY CODE 6.18

Any animal rescue entity operating in whole or in part in Douglas County shall apply for, obtain, and continuously maintain in force, for so long as it operates as an animal rescue entity, an animal rescue entity license issued by Animal Control.

Animal Control shall not issue to or renew a license under Douglas County Code 6.18 unless the animal rescue entity demonstrates it is in compliance with the Douglas County Code.

The undersigned certifies they understand that in order to be issued and retain an animal rescue entity license, that the entity must apply for, obtain, and maintain in force an animal rescue entity license; comply at all times with the provisions of Douglas County Code 6.18; provide at all times to animals in the custody or control of the animal rescue entity minimum care as defined by Douglas County Code 6.18; comply with all requirements of applicable federal, state and local laws and ordinances pertaining to the operation of animal rescue entities; and; commit no offense described in subsection 6.18.030 C. of the Douglas County Code.
